Bite Delight Recipes

Read the recipes for these Bite Delight treats to determine which suspect might have left traces of powdered sugar beside the desk.

Mysterious Treat

1 c. shortening 2 eggs

1 tsp. vanilla 1 c. brown sugar

1 c. crushed potato chips 1 c. white sugar

3/4 c. nuts 1 T. baking soda

Cream shortening, sugar and eggs until creamy. Add remaining ingredients.

Mix. Drop by teaspoons onto cookie sheet and slightly flatten with a fork.

Bake at 350° for 10 minutes. Cool. Dust with powdered sugar.



Tasty Dandies

1 T. vanilla 1 c. butter powdered sugar 4 T. powdered sugar

2 c. flour 1 ½ tsp. baking

powder

Cream butter and sugar. Add flour, baking powder and salt. Add vanilla and nuts. Drop in one inch balls on a greased cookie sheet. Bake at 375° until brown. Roll in powdered sugar.



Incredible Squares

³/₄ c. chopped nuts ½ stick butter ³/₄ c. chocolate syrup 1 c. sugar powdered sugar 3 eggs dash of salt 2 c. flour

Cream butter and sugar. Add eggs. Add flour and salt to the creamed mixture. Add chopped nuts, chocolate syrup and vanilla. Pour into greased and floured 9-inch square pan. Bake at 350° for 35 minutes. Cool. Sprinkle with powdered sugar.

Chocolate Bites

2 tsp. vanilla 1 c. butter 2 ½ c. flour 3/4 c. sugar ½ tsp. salt 3/4 c. brown sugar

1 tsp. baking soda 2 eggs 24 oz. chocolate chips 2 c. flour

Cream butter and sugar. Add eggs and vanilla. Beat in flour, salt, and soda. Fold in chocolate chips. Bake at 375° on an ungreased sheet for 8-10 minutes.

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Coconut Delights

1 tsp. vanilla 2 sticks butter 1-3 oz. coconut 1 ½ c. sugar powdered sugar 2 c. flour

Cream butter and sugar. Add flour, vanilla and coconut. Roll into small balls. Put on a cookie sheet. Flatten with a fork. Bake at 350° for 20-25 minutes. Cool and dust with powdered sugar.
